Program Guidelines

1. The Operation Save-A-Life program should be presented by an A.B.A.T.E. member and by others who have seen the program presented by an A.B.A.T.E. member and have signed the OSAL “Agreement Release Form”. This program is not to be handed out to the uninformed public.

Note: The language in this “Script Packet” is directed toward members of A.B.A.T.E. of PA. Individuals, organizations and others who have received the OSAL program from an A.B.A.T.E. member may use any information contained herein as appropriate.

2. You may personalize any part of the presentation EXCEPT the accident scene.
3. The script should be followed as close as possible, but does not have to be presented verbatim.
4. Videotaping your presentation is a good idea. It will help you to recognize problem areas in your presentation group.
5. Report all presentations to the State OSAL Director. This will enable him/her to share with other chapters the information you find helpful when presenting the program. It will also help track where the program has been presented.
6. Use props if you are able to. Motorcycles, leathers, helmets, lights, sirens, and backdrops such as safety posters and A.B.A.T.E. banners are attention getters.
7. Be prepared to answer any questions. You should know your sources for any quotes about facts or statistics.
8. Discuss and promote the Pennsylvania Motorcycle Safety Program. Recommend that anyone interested in riding a motorcycle take the Motorcycle Safety Course.
9. You may need to purchase additional audiovisual aids if you do not already have these items available. A fundraiser will help offset the cost of your program.
10. Correspondence should be typed or photocopied onto quality paper. Please remember to include a self-addressed, stamped envelope for the Program Evaluation sheet.
11. Enjoy yourself! Remember, you are helping to save lives, maybe even your own.
